

Cultural Committee Annual Report – 2019-20

[1] “World Yoga Day” was celebrated on 21-6-2019 at 8.30 a.m. jointly organized by S.D. Arts & B.R. Commerce College and Sheth L.H. Science College, Mansa. The principals of both the colleges, teaching and non-teaching staff, and students very eagerly participated in this event, it was demonstrated by Anilbhai Prajapati, a yoga teacher from Patanjali Yogpith, Mansa.
