(5) On 15th August, 2020, the Indian Independence Day was celebrated. The retiring professor A.B. Soni hoisted the Indian National Flag and


gave a speech. The entire college staff and NCC Cadets saluted the flag.




(6) On 29th August, 2020, in "Fit for India Program", an online event was organized in the college by NCC Unit and NSS Department of the
